

## Questions... but more important, Answers!

Do we share a bathroom? No. The entire cottage is Yours and Yours Alone. Think of the cottage as a small house. You have your own living room, kitchen, bathroom, and bedroom. You only share with each other.

Do you have neighbors? Yes, but they are a suitable distance away. There is a neighbor to the north that is about 300 feet away. There are neighbors to the east, but they are over 500 feet away.
